SAFETY TIP

Turning -

There are four key steps to turning:

1. slow
2. look
3. lean
4. roll

Slow - reduce speed before the turn by closing the throttle and, if necessary, applying both brakes.

Look - Use your head and eyes for directional control. Look through the turn to where you want to go. Turn your head, not your shoulders or just your eyes.

Lean - to turn, the motorcycle must lean. To lean the motorcycle, press on the handgrip in the direction of the turn. Press left - lean left - go left. Press right - lean right - go right. Higher speeds and/or tighter turns require more lean. In normal turns, the rider and motorcycle should lean together. In slow tight turns, lean the motorcycle only and keep your body straight.

Roll - Roll on the throttle through the turn. Maintain steady speed or gently accelerate. Avoid deceleration or rapid acceleration while in the turn.
